SWEARING IN OF NEW ELECTED OFFICIALS Following the special meeting, at 6:00 p.m. the new elected officials were sworn into office. Outgoing Mayor Hewitt gave the oath of office to incoming Mayor Munyon. Mayor Munyon gave the oath of office to Councilmembers Bret Miles, Terry McConnell, and Mike James. Mayor Munyon thanked outgoing Mayor Hewitt and Councilmembers Donna Speake and Rod Innes for their years of service. Mayor Pat Hewitt held the office of mayor twice serving in 1999-2001 and April 2015- January 2018. Councilmember Donna Speak was appointed by Mayor Fred Robinson in May 2014 to fill an unexpired term council position until January 2018. Councilmember Rod Innes served on the Phillipsburg Housing Authority Board prior to being appointed by Mayor Ken Hiatt to fill an unexpired term on the city council in October 1987 and he served until April 1993. Innes was then elected as Mayor of the city for the 1993-1995 term. After a two year break, Innes was elected to the city council in April 1997 and continued to serve until January 2018.
