- Sports Complex        Munyon reported the topographic survey of the future site of the Albert and Leona Morgan sports complex was completed in May, and the engineer provided a concept design and estimated cost of \$3.2 million to build it.
- Fundraising            Munyon provided a report written by Community Development Director Scotty Aust, who was absent due to a death in the family. Aust reported he planned to submit a concept proposal to KDOT for a potential grant for the park and citywide walking trails.
- Aust asked the board to provide input on the fundraising brochure. The brochure is ready to be printed and will be mailed to residents and alumni.
- Housing                 Aust provide the board information about the RHID (Rural Housing Incentive District) program and asked them to review it at their convenience.
- City Stimulus          Munyon discussed the city's economic stimulus effort designed to get people shopping at local stores of their choice. No action was taken.
