ORDINANCE NO. 1424

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE 1401, WHICH PERTAINS TO ELECTIONS; AND REPEALING SAID SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE 1401 AS ORIGINALLY ADOPTED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Section 5 of Ordinance 1401 of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6-101. ELECTIONS. That Senate Bill 105 authorizes a city to determine the start date of a regular term of office for a city officer by resolution of the city. Said Senate Bill requires the start date be on or after December 1 following certification of the election and no later than the second Monday in January thereafter. The mayor, treasurer, and one councilman from each ward shall be elected on the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday of each odd numbered year beginning November 2021, and one councilman from each ward shall be elected on the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday of each odd numbered year beginning November 2023. The mayor and treasurer shall have terms of two years and the councilmen shall have terms of four years. All shall hold office until their successors are qualified. To be qualified to hold an office each officer, after receipt of certificate of election from the county election commissioners, must take and subscribe an oath. Failure to so qualify is deemed a refusal to accept said office. The start date of a regular term of office for a city officer shall hereafter be determined by Resolution of the Governing Body of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas.




