ORDINANCE NO. 1426

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7-407 (b) OF ORDINANCE 1384 AS ORIGINALLY WRITTEN AND AS FURTHER AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 1390 AND ADOPTING NEW SECTION 7-407 (c) ENTITLED "SPECIAL USE EVENT PERMIT" WHICH PERTAINS TO DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS, ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 7-407 (b) of Ordinance 1384 and as amended by Ordinance 1390 of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7-407 (b). DISCHARGE ON PRIVATE PROPERTY. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge, ignite or fire any fireworks upon any private property within the city, except when fireworks legally go on sale from June 27 until July 5, Superbowl Sunday, Memorial Day, Labor Day, and New Year's Eve of each year. During the period and dates fireworks may be discharged, ignited or fired upon any private property within the city, same may be discharged, ignited or fired from 8:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.; except, Superbowl Sunday, Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, and New Year's Eve wherein same may be discharged, ignited or fired from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 a.m. midnight.

7-407 (c). SPECIAL USE EVENT PERMIT. A Special Use Event Permit may be obtained from the city to discharge, ignite or fire fireworks by filing with the city office during posted office hours, Monday thru Friday, a special use event permit form at least 72 hours prior to the special use event date. The time, place, and manner for the allowed discharge of fireworks will be specified therein and in no event earlier than 8:00 a.m. or later than 10:00 p.m. A special use event includes but is not limited to: a home athletic sporting event, homecoming event, birthday celebration, family event, etc.

SECTION 2. That Section 7-407 (b) of Ordinance 1384 as originally written November 18, 2013, and as further amended by Ordinance 1390, adopted July 20, 2015, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That new Section 7-407 (c) is hereby adopted into Ordinance 1384.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas.
