CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 15

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 12-2222, HEREBY AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNING BODY TO APPOINT LIBRARY BOARD MEMBERS RESIDING OUTSIDE OF THE MUNICIPALITY BUT WITHIN U.S.D. 325 SCHOOL DISTRICT TO THE LIBRARY BOARD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5, of the Constitution of the State of Kansas hereby elects to and does exempt itself and make inapplicable to it the provisions of K.S.A. 12-2222, (same being part of an enactment of such city, but not applicable uniformly to all cities), relative to residence requirements for library board members, and further provide for a substitute provision regarding the subject of residence requirements for library board members for the Phillipsburg Public Library.

SECTION 2. All appointed members to the Library Board shall be residents of the municipality, except the Mayor with the approval of the Governing Body may appoint as members of the Library Board, a maximum of two residents from outside the city, but residing within U.S.D. 325 School District.


SECTION 3. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 4. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed requiring a referendum to be held on the Charter Ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective if approved by the majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL THE 3rd DAY OF AUGUST, 2020, WITH NOT LESS THAN 2/3RDS OF THE ELECTED MEMBERS VOTING IN FAVOR THEREOF.
