ORDINANCE NO. 1351

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 4-202, 4-302, 4-402 AND 7-201 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS, 2008, AND REPEALING SAID SECTIONS 4-202, 4-302, 4-402, AND 7-201 AS ORIGINALLY ADOPTED. THIS ORDINANCE PERTAINS TO ADOPTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE, 2006 EDITION; ADOPTION OF THE UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE, 2006 EDITION; ADOPTION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 2008 EDITION; AND ADOPTION OF THE NATIONAL FIRE CODES OF THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION, 2006 EDITION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Section 4-202 of the Code to the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4-202. INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE INCORPORATED.

There is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference, for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for the construction, alteration, removal, demolition, equipment, use and occupancy, location and maintenance of buildings and structures, the International Building Code, 2006 Edition, as recommended by the International Conference of Building Officials, such code being made as a part of the ordinances and code of the city as if the same had been set out in full herein, all as authorized and in the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012 including any amendments thereto. No fewer than three copies of the International Building Code, 2006 Edition, shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the Code of the City of Phillipsburg," and shall be filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours of business.

Any person violating any provision of such code shall be punished as provided in section 1-116 of this code. (Code 2008)

Section 2. That Section 4-202, entitled INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE INCORPORATED, of the Code of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, 2008, as originally adopted is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That Section 4-302 of the Code of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4-302. UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE INCORPORATED.

There is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference, for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for the practice of plumbing and gas-fitting, including the installation, maintenance, extension and alteration of all pipes, fixtures, appliances and appurtenances in connection with sanitary sewers and public and private water and fuel gas systems, the Uniform Plumbing Code, 2006 Edition, as recommended by the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials, such code being made as a part of the ordinances and code of the city as if the same had been set out in full herein, all as authorized and in the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012 including any amendments thereto. No fewer than three copies of the uniform code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the Code of the City of Phillipsburg," and shall be filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours of business.

Any person violating any provisions of such code shall be punished as provided in section 1-116 of this code. (Code 2008)

Section 4. That Section 4-302, entitled UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE INCORPORATED, of the Code of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, 2008, as originally adopted is hereby repealed.

Section 5. That Section 4-402 of the Code to the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4-402. ADOPTION OF ELECTRICAL CODE BY REFERENCE.

The standard code known as the National Electrical Code of 2008, a publication of the National Fire Protection Association, the same being a standard code for the installation of electrical wiring and apparatus and available in book and pamphlet form is hereby incorporated by reference herein and made a part of this article as authorized and in the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012 including any amendments thereto. Three copies shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the Code of the City of Phillipsburg," and shall be filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours of business.

Any person violating any provision of such code shall be punished as provided in section 1-116 of this code. (Code 2008)

Section 6. That Section 4-402, entitled ADOPTION OF ELECTRICAL CODE BY REFERENCE, of the Code of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, 2008, as originally adopted is hereby repealed.

Section 7. That Section 7-201 of the Code to the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:


7-201. FIRE PREVENTION CODE INCORPORATED.

There is hereby adopted by the governing body of the city, for the purpose of prescribing regulations, governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire or explosion, that certain code and standards known as the Uniform Fire Code, edition of 2006, including all the Appendix chapters, and the Uniform Fire Code Standards, and the National Fire Codes of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 2006 and amendments hereafter, Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 2006 and amendments hereafter, published by the Western Fire Chiefs Association and the International Conference of Building Officials, being particularly the 2006 editions thereof and the whole thereof, save and except such portions as hereinafter deleted, modified or amended by section 7-203 of this article three copies which code and standards have been and are now filed in the office of the clerk of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, and the same are hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein, and from the date on which this ordinance shall take effect, the provisions thereof shall be controlling within the limits of the city. (Code 2008)

Section 8. That Section 7-201, entitled FIRE PREVENTION CODE INCORPORATED, of the Code of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, 2008, as originally adopted is hereby repealed.



