ORDINANCE NO. 1403

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15-304 OF ORDINANCE 1384, WHICH PERTAINS TO SERVICE CONNECTION FEES; AND REPEALING SECTION 15-304 OF ORDINANCE 1384, AS ORIGINALLY ADOPTED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 15-304 of Ordinance 1384 of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

15-304. SERVICE CONNECTION FEES.

- A. A Service Connection Fee for new Water service must be paid prior to service being established. Service Connection Fees cannot be transferred from one customer to another.
1. Water (Residential): \$25.00 nonrefundable fee, which must be paid in full before service is connected.
 2. Water (Commercial): \$25.00 nonrefundable fee, which must be paid in full before service is connected.
- B. TRANSFER and TRANSFER FEE: Water users shall be charged a transfer fee of \$25.00 for each service: 1) desiring to have their water physically connected/disconnected for a period of time (i.e. vacation, sprinkler, cleaning); 2) moving from one address to another address. A transfer fee will not be charged when only changing names on the account, such as from a deceased person's name to their estate name or between roommates, if there is no water meter reading required.
- C. SERVICE DISCONTINUED DUE TO DELINQUENT BILL: A \$25 nonrefundable service fee along with the full delinquent bill will be paid prior to water service being reestablished.

SECTION 2. That Section 15-304 of Ordinance 1384 of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, as originally written and approved on November 18, 2013, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas.
