ORDINANCE NO. 1405

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS CREATING A SPECIAL FUND WITHIN THE TREASUREY OF THE CITY AS A SPECIAL FUND FOR THE OPERATION, MAINTENANCE, AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas (the "City") has heretofore operated a fire department within the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas (the "City") has contracted with the Phillips County Rural Fire District #1 to maintain the rural fire trucks and equipment and furnish firefighting service to all property within the boundaries set forth as Phillips County, Kansas Rural Fire District No. 1; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has found and determined that it would be in the public interest to create with the treasury of the City a special fund, in which money can be budgeted and appropriated from year to year for the continued operation, maintenance, and improvement of the Fire Department.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS:

Section 1. There is hereby created within the treasury of the City a special fund, to be called "Fire Department", into which shall be deposited moneys intended to be used for purposes of paying the cost of operation, maintenance, and improvement of the Fire Department from (a) gifts, grants or bequests from private individuals, corporations, or foundations, (b) appropriations and transfers from other funds including but not limited to the General Fund so designated by the Governing Body. Moneys deposited in such fund shall be used exclusively for such purposes as appropriated in the discretion of the governing body, and, as to private funds contributed to such fund, consistent with the intent of any donor, or any restrictions placed on gifts, grants, or bequests from any donor.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas.


