**ORDINANCE NO. 1410**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1403 AS ORIGINALLY WRITTEN, WHICH PERTAINS TO SERVICE CONNECTION FEES; AND REPEALING SAID ORDINANCE 1403 AS ORIGINALLY ADOPTED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance 1403 of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

15-304. SERVICE CONNECTION FEE.


- A. A Service Connection Fee for new Water and/or Sewer service must be paid prior to service being established. If the customer has been a previous customer of the City and has not had service disconnected due to being delinquent on payment for any prior city utility bill, the Service Connection Fee may be paid on the first billing statement following said service connection. The Service Connection Fee cannot be transferred from one customer to another.
  - 1. Water and/or Sewer (Residential): \$25.00 nonrefundable fee.
  - 2. Water and/or Sewer (Commercial): \$25.00 nonrefundable fee.
- B. TRANSFER and TRANSFER FEE: Water users shall be charged a transfer fee of \$25.00 for each service: 1) desiring to have their water physically connected/disconnected for a period of time (i.e. vacation, sprinkler, cleaning); 2) moving from one address to another address. A transfer fee will not be charged when only changing names on the account, such as from a deceased person's name to their estate name or between roommates, if there is no water meter reading required.
- C. SERVICE DISCONTINUED DUE TO DELINQUENT BILL: a \$25.00 nonrefundable service fee along with the full delinquent bill will be paid prior to water service being reestablished.

SECTION 2. That Ordinance 1403 as originally written and approved on June 5, 2017 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas.
