ORDINANCE NO. 1416

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14-209 ENTITLED "CERTAIN TRUCKS PROHIBITED", WITHIN ORDINANCE 1384 OF THE CODE TO THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS; AND REPEALING SAID SECTION 14-209 AS ORIGINALLY ADOPTED WITHIN ORDINANCE 1384, NOVEMBER 18, 2013.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Section 14-209 of Ordinance 1384 of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:


14-209. CERTAIN TRUCKS PROHIBITED. No truck or other commercial vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of 8,000 pounds or more, shall be operated on any of the hard surfaced streets in the city, except on U.S. Highways 36 and 183, unless the operator shall have a pickup or unload destination within the city limits on said street or route, and in which case parking shall be only for a reasonable time for the loading and unloading operation.

Section 2. REPEAL. That Section 14-209 of Ordinance 1384 of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, as originally written and approved on November 18, 2013, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.


