CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 14

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 14-1501, AS APPLICABLE TO THE CITY CLERK OFFICE ONLY; NAMELY THE CITY CLERK OFFICE WILL NO LONGER BE BY APPOINTMENT, NOT HAVE PREREQUISITES, WILL NOT HAVE A TERM, AND K.S.A. 14-1501 SHALL NOT APPLY TO A VACANCY IN SAID OFFICE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS:


SECTION 1. The City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas hereby elects to and does exempt itself and make inapplicable to it the provisions of K.S.A. 14-1501 as same applies to the City Clerk Office. The Office of the City Clerk shall no longer be by appointment, not have prerequisites, will not have a term of office, and K.S.A. 14-1501 shall not apply to a vacancy in said office.

SECTION 2. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.


SECTION 3. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filled and a referendum held on the Charter Ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective if approved by the majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL THE 19th DAY OF November, 2018, WITH NOT LESS THAN 2/3RDS OF THE ELECTED MEMBERS VOTING IN FAVOR THEREOF.
