CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 13

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 14-205, PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT AND REMOVING LIMITATIONS ON RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CITY CLERK.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas hereby elects to and does exempt itself and make inapplicable to it the provisions of K.S.A. 14-205 which applies to this city, but is part of an enactment which does not apply uniformly to all cities, insofar as said statute requires that the city clerk meet certain residency requirements.

SECTION 2. The governing body of the City Phillipsburg, Kansas, shall be qualified electors of said city.

SECTION 3. The city clerk need not be a qualified elector of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, and may reside outside of the city limits of said city up to a radius of 35 miles from the city limits of City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, and must reside within the state of Kansas.

SECTION 4. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 5. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the Charter Ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective if approved by the majority of the electors thereon.

PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL THE 21st DAY OF MAY, 2018, WITH NOT LESS THAN 2/3RDS OF THE ELECTED MEMBERS VOTING IN FAVOR THEREOF.
